2018 Fall Clean-up

The Madison Diocese Cemeteries are getting ready to begin our annual fall clean up. All grave and crypt decorations that families wish to retain should be removed from the graves and crypts by October 14, 2018. The cemetery staff will remove and dispose of remaining decorations. Bronze vases will be turned down and are to remain until April 16, 2019. Winter decorations may be placed on graves and crypts beginning November 16, 2018. Flags may be placed on graves for Veteran's Day, no sooner than November 11, 2018. Year round flags should be in a proper flag holder. Check with the appropriate office for assistance in acquiring the approved VA flag holders.
